The Asia-Pacific Management Accounting Association (APMAA) holds its 2022 Annual Conference (APMAA 2022) at Dhurakij Pundit University, Bangkok, Thailand on 9 (Wednesday) - 11 (Friday), November 2022.

The conference theme is "Management Accounting: Recent Themes and Directions for a Digital Future." Today, technology is reshaping the digital landscape of the organization and the associated business models. We have observed the automation and robotization of routine procedures, the introduction of business intelligence, and the application of data analytics. In the accounting area, digital technologies such as the cloud, big data, blockchain, and artificial intelligence are going to be influenced on record-keeping and accounting information use, auditing, and compliance processes.

Data scientists collect, organize, validate, mine, and analyze data. Management accountants use data analytics to support value creation, which can be through increasing efficiency, improving profitability and cash flow, but also through customer management, innovation, and intellectual property. One can use big data to discover behavioral patterns in consumer and market trends that accountants can use to identify profitable investment opportunities. Digitalization seems to have disrupted the accounting domain. We need to change education programs and curricula to prepare accounting students for work in a digital environment.

However, there is still scarce academic research about digitalization in accounting and its impact on practices, education, and research. Let's discuss these important issues together at the 2022 annual conference. Please submit your research outputs in the area. As in every other year, we provide broad subject areas encompassing various fields for your manuscript submissions and accept manuscripts covering an extensive range of management accounting subjects. We welcome illustrative or teaching case studies, in addition to high-quality manuscripts describing empirical, experimental, or theoretical work.

The Asia-Pacific Management Accounting Association, founded in 2004, is a "members-first" organization. Our annual conferences and the doctoral colloquiums are the platforms that bring us together. Academic Paper Sessions have always been the center of the APMAA annual conferences. We have continuously developed conference programs and schedules that were "of the members," "by the members," and "for the members (APMAA Annual Conference Policy and Mission). APMAA is a "members-first" organization.

Under the current competitive environment among academic associations, we are keen to provide quality service to our members. Guideline for Authors

1. All submitted manuscripts should report original, unpublished research results.

2. The official language of APMAA 2022 is **English** in both writing and presentation. If English is not your mother tongue (first language), check your draft using a professional editor and/or with a



spelling and grammar matching application such as **Grammarly** before submitting your manuscript. You can download a free version and install it on your PC. If your document is hard to read, we will decline it before sending it to our Reviewer.

3. Manuscripts should follow **the structure of a traditional research paper**, i. e., you will need to adjust your document to the **academic format** so that it can be accepted. An empirical research paper's typical organization is Title, Abstract, Introduction, Literature Review and Hypothesis Development, Method, Findings and Discussion, Conclusions, and References.

4. Use Times New Roman font with font size 12, page size A4, single-spaced.

5. Abstract should be 200-300 words on a separate page immediately preceding the text. Show five keywords below the abstract. The text should be as concise as the subject and research method permit. To be considered, the text length should be over 5,000 but usually not exceed 10,000 words.

6. The cover page should contain the title of the paper, the author's name (first name, initial(s), and family name), position, and affiliation (**capitalize the first character of each word**). Also, contain email addresses and phone numbers. Please indicate the **corresponding author**. About the detailed information for formatting, please follow the **2022 Guideline for Authors (Formatting and Template**) at <u>APMAA 2022 annual conference (Asia-Pacific Management Accounting Association) (sakura.ne.jp)</u>

7. To promote anonymous review, authors should not identify themselves directly or indirectly in their writing.

8. Author(s) should not use the pronoun "I" or "we." Instead, please use "this study" or "this research." Referencing should follow the APA style (<u>APA Style</u>).

9. Each author registering for the conference is limited to two (2) full-length paper submissions (including co-author papers) for the Academic Paper Sessions.

10. Authors who received a "Minor Revision" or "Major Revision" notification are expected to resubmit their revised (final) manuscripts before a specified date (the temporal deadline is **August 20**) to get an "Accept" notification by September 1. Our review team engages in review on a first-come-first-served basis.

11. All authors of accepted manuscripts must register, complete, and submit their **camera-ready full-length papers for inclusion in the conference proceedings** before the due date (Sep.15, 2022). This ensures that their manuscripts will be included in the in-house proceedings (a collection of camera-ready full-length papers). Authors, in principle, cannot make their presentations if they refuse to have their full-length papers included in the conference proceedings. Alternatively, authors can submit a short camera-ready paper whose length is no less than 5,000 words when he/she gets permission beforehand from the Academic Paper Sessions Chair.

12. To attend and present their papers, at least one of the authors must register (pay the participation fee) for the Conference before September 15, 2022.

Call for 2022 APMAA Research Prize Papers

Over the past few decades, digital technology development and applications have brought remarkable changes in all business processes: strategic planning, procurement control,



productions, new product/service design, inventory control, distribution, marketing, logistics, and the like. Applying cutting-edge digital technologies (e.g., the Internet of Things (IoT), robotics, cloud computing, big data analytics, and artificial intelligence) can force a disruptive realignment of traditional business styles.

Digitalization seems to have disrupted the accounting domain also. The challenges of management accounting in the digital era deserve a strong research focus. 2022 APMAA Research Prize Papers seek both theoretical and empirical studies that may address "Management Accounting: Recent Themes and Directions for a Digital Future."

Objective

To attract good quality papers relevant to the 2022 conference theme, "Management Accounting: Recent Themes and Directions for a Digital Future," APMAA 2022 Annual Conference will have a Research Prize.

Subject Area for Prize

Evaluation Committee and Judging Process

-The evaluation committee will compile a shortlist of outstanding papers and rank them. -The APMAA Chair and Deputy Chair decide on the award-winning paper.

Award

The winner (s) will be announced and bestowed at the conference closing session. The author of an awarded paper, and co-authors, if any, will be entitled to:

-A signed and stamped official award certificate;

-The announcement of their achievement on the conference webpage;

-500 US Dollars.

(We will transfer the prize money to the winner's bank after the conference.)

Peer-Review and presentation (tentative)

All submissions are subject to a two-tier review. First is the desk review by Gatekeepers, who assess the paper's suitability in terms of title/topic, format, and overall grammar. Second is a single-blind peer-review process organized by the Review Team consisting of a panel of leading scholars. The submitting author(s) will be notified of the acceptance decision by September 1, 2022.

APMAA has guidelines for presenters, moderators, and discussants beneficial to all, including audiences. 4. APMAA 2022 Doctoral Colloquium Call for Papers

We hold the 2022 Doctoral Colloquium in conjunction with the APMAA 2022 Conference. Our Doctoral Colloquium will offer doctoral students an opportunity to receive high-quality feedback



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from external advisers (mentors), interact with peers, exchange ideas, discuss concepts, and establish (in) formal cooperation with various research groups. In **mentorship**, a more experienced or more knowledgeable person helps guide a less experienced or less knowledgeable person. The mentors comprise a group of international professors.

Doctoral students and candidates at all stages are welcome to submit a thesis-position paper, but preference will be given to students in the earlier stages of their doctoral work. Doctoral students interested in participating in the Doctoral Colloquium should submit a single file (in both PDF and Word) consisting of:

1. **An introductory letter** in which you indicate what you wish to obtain from the Doctoral Colloquium and what you will be bringing to the Doctoral Colloquium.

2. A one-page research statement in the research field you will pursue. This statement should focus on the dissertation if you are at the doctoral dissertation stage.

3. Your CV.

4. A letter of recommendation from your primary dissertation advisor should state what you could contribute and gain from the doctoral consortium.

5. Your research paper

The submitted paper should clearly state:

- 1. An overview of related work in the area of the doctoral work
- 2. The original fundamental idea/research questions/hypothesis of the thesis
- 3. The problem domain and the specific problem addressed
- 4. Methodological approach
- 5. The expected contributions
- 6. Research carried out

Notification:

1. The **first author** should be a doctoral student responsible for researching the topic. If the supervisor becomes a co-author, he or she should be a second or subsequent author.

2. The **abstract** should be **200-300 words** on a separate page immediately preceding the text. Show **five keywords** below the abstract. **The text** should be as concise as the subject and research method permit. The text length should be about **4,000- 8,000 words**. (If not, Desk Rejected). Use **Times New Roman font** with **font size 12**, **page size A4**, **single-spaced**. About the detailed information for formatting, please follow the **2022 Guideline for Authors** (**Formatting and Template**) at <u>APMAA</u> 2022 annual conference (Asia-Pacific Management Accounting Association) (sakura.ne.jp).

3. The colloquium chairs will arrange the selection of the accepted papers using a peer-review process.

4. Accepted manuscripts whose first author (doctoral student) will have completed registration and submission of the **camera-ready full-length paper** before the due date (Sep.15, 2022) will be included in the in-house proceedings (a collection of camera-ready full-length papers). Authors, in principle, cannot make their presentations if they refuse to have their full-length papers included in the conference proceedings. Alternatively, authors can submit a short camera-ready paper whose length is no less than 4,000 words when they get **permission** beforehand from the Doctoral Colloquium Chair.

Requirement and Due Application Date

To serve as a reviewer, moderator, discussant, and mentor, you must (1) **participate in an online training program** and a **rehearsal** provided by APMAA and (2) **register for the 2022 Annual Conference by September 15**. Application Due Dates are as below;

-Reviewers: we encourage you to apply before May 30.

-Mentors of the Doctoral Colloquium: we encourage you to apply before June 30.

-Moderators and Discussants: we encourage you to apply before August 30. Note that we give reviewers and presenters a priority to serve as a moderator and a mentor.

The Academic Papers review process (tentative)

We review submitted academic papers within the CMT system. Our review process is as follows: -A Gatekeeper (Meta-Reviewers) checks the paper's academic format (**organization, figures, references, length of the abstract and text, keywords**, etc.) and **English**. When the paper <u>fails to</u> <u>satisfy</u> minimum standards, the Gatekeeper edits and submits his/her review report (Meta-Review Questions in the APMAA 2022 CMT) to the Chief gatekeeper, including comments and suggestions for improving the paper. The Chief gatekeeper notifies the corresponding author of the "Desk Rejected" decision with the review report (Meta-Review Review Questions) received from the Gatekeeper and recommends the authors a **modification** or withdrawal. Authors can resubmit a disk rejected paper by July 15 after sufficient improvement.



-When the paper satisfies minimum standards, the Gatekeepers assign a (one) reviewer.

-The Reviewer edits the REVIEWER'S EVALUATION FORM (Review Questions in the APMAA 2022 CMT)) that includes descriptive comments and suggestions (100 words or more) and submits a recommendation to the Gatekeeper.

- When Reviewer's recommendation is "Minor Revision" or "Major Revision," the Gatekeeper edits the REVIEWER'S EVALUATION FORM (Meta-Review Questions). And ask corresponding author resubmissions after modification (via CMT mails).

-The Gatekeepers (or Reviewers) confirm (review) minor (major) revision papers resubmitted before August 20 (tentative).

-Gatekeepers edit a review report (Meta-Review Questions) and pass it to the Chief gatekeeper.

-The Chief gatekeeper notifies either "Accepted" or "Rejected" **decision** to the corresponding author by September 1 (by CMT mails).

Gatekeeper* of the Academic Paper Sessions: A Gatekeeper checks the paper's (1) academic format (organization, figures, references, length of the abstract and text, keywords, etc.) and (2) readability (English, etc.). The four main sections of an academic paper are the Title page, Abstract, Main body (Title, Abstract, Introduction, Literature Review and Hypothesis Development, Method, Findings and Discussion, Conclusions), and References

The Moderator (A subject-area reviewer sometimes serves this role)

As an Academic Paper Sessions moderator, your central role is to provide organization and cohesion to the session assigned. You should be familiar with all papers to be presented in your session. The duties of the moderator include the following:

1. Before the conference, contact each presenting author and discussants in your assigned session and provide them information on session structure (time limits, presentation order, etc.). Request them to provide you with any updates, including changes in affiliation or any changes as to the author presenting the paper at the conference. Also, request the authors send the paper to the discussant if it has undergone major revisions.

2. Arrive at the session before the session begins. Identify the paper presenters and discussant(s) in advance, and introduce yourself. Remind each presenter of the time limits that apply, and describe the method you will use to alert them of time limits during the actual presentation.

3. At the start of the session, introduce yourself to the audience, announce the session/title, and offer a brief overview of the session structure. How many papers will be presented, the time each presenting author will have for the presentation, when the discussant will provide comments, and when the audience will have the opportunity to ask questions or provide comments.

4. For each paper, introduce the presenter, her/his affiliation, and the paper title.

5. During the presentations, enforce time limits strictly so that no author (or audience) monopolizes someone else's time. It is your job to moderate the Q&A session involving the audience. Please ensure that the session *finishes on time*. Sessions that overrun will affect the following sessions.

6. If an assigned discussant is a **no-show**, you can fill in and provide some comments on the paper. If a paper presenter is unexpectedly absent, the moderator should exercise judgment by either allowing extra time for the other papers or dismissing the session early.

7. Participate in online rehearsal scheduled two weeks and two days before the conference date. You will have an online meeting with discussants and presenters at the trial to ensure you can do your role well at the APMAA 2022.

The Discussant (A subject-area reviewer sometimes serves this role) The duties of an Academic Paper Sessions discussant include the following:

1. Please read an assigned paper carefully and come prepared to comment (in PPT slides) on the paper. Your comments can include constructive criticism about the research questions addressed, the theoretical foundations established, the methodologies employed, the analyses and results presented, the implications derived, and others. Importantly, your time as a discussant should be spent stimulating audience interest in the subject and the papers. Preparation and attentiveness during the session are keys to successfully serving the discussant's role.

2. As a discussant, please limit your remarks to the allocated time so that ample time is left for audience participation. If you have more detailed comments on the paper (e.g., written comments, marked-up copy, or other verbal comments), you can provide these to the authors after the session.

3. If an emergency precludes your attendance at the conference, please make every effort to inform the session's moderator and the Session Liaison in advance.

4. Participate in online rehearsals scheduled two weeks and two days before the conference date. You will have an online meeting at the rehearsal with the moderator, other discussants, and presenters to ensure you can do your role well at the APMAA 2022.
