Dear APMAA Community,

A Happy New Year! It is a great honor for me to serve as the Chair of the APMAA Board of Directors since 2014. I understand this honor entails tremendous responsibilities on my shoulders and I have to commit myself with on-going efforts to further develop our Association.

APMAA was formally established in 2004. The association has grown steadily but slowly. On January 1, 2010, I succeeded Prof. Akira Nishimura, the first president since the foundation of the association, and served as the APMAA president until the end of 2013. In the President's Opening Remark at APMAA 2010 held in Taipei on November 5, 2010, I disclosed my policy below:

"APMAA is a very young academic organization, and it is still at its infant stage. In order to further develop the organization and to ensure its growth, APMAA must attract more people to join us as members. In other words, we must enhance people's awareness to our organization *by fully utilizing our communication vehicles, i.e.,* annual forums (renamed "conferences" after 2011), APMA Journal (APMAJ), Newsletters, and the website, <u>http://www.apmaa.asia/</u>."

APMAA increased its visibility year by year. On January 1, 2014, APMAA created new position, Chair of the Board of Directors, to achieve its growth further. I became the Board Chair, and Professor Jimmy Tsay the 2014 president. My position with the association has changed over time, however, I continued the 2010 policy described above. Much progress has been made in APMAA in the past decade.

The 2017 (13th) conference (APMAA 2017) led by President Yiming Hu at Shanghai Jiao Tong University attracted over 60 international participants from over the world. Total participants were over 120. The conference organizing team at the university strived for leading the conference at academically high quality by inviting talented overseas and domestic professors. The 2018 (14th) conference (APMAA 2018) will be held at Waseda Campus of Waseda University, Tokyo, from October 29 to November 1.

In this new year issue of APMAA NEWWS, I report that we could make a certain progress about determining future conference venues also. Bellows are future conference venues that we have already deliberated, and they are officially approved until today.

Book Review by Scarbrough, Paul, Brock University, Canada



The Routledge Handbook of Accounting in Asia, Edited by <u>Zhijun Lin</u>. Routledge, 2018 (ISBN 978-1-138-18903-4).

The new Routledge Handbook of Accounting in Asia adds important information to our knowledge of the development and current state of accounting throughout Asia. This book is an important resource for students and businesses, which we should add to our university libraries.

With the extremely strong, although unequal, development of the economic power of Asian countries, it is important to understand the impact and development of accounting here. This book does a very thorough job of presenting both the development and current state of accounting practices.

The book examines all aspects of accounting: Financial Accounting and Reporting, Managerial Accounting, Accounting and Audit professionalization, Government and public sector accounting, Accounting education, and Accounting development in the newly emerging economies of Vietnam, Bangladesh, Cambodia and Mongolia. Documenting the tremendous diversity of practices across all these aspects is a crucial aspect of this book. Even with the ease of access to "current" information in the internet era, this book shows that national historical experiences lead to significant diversity of practices.

In particular, the coverage of both the stronger and more extensively developed economies (such as Japan), as well as the more recently developing economies (such as Viet Nam) is a strength of the book. Japan intensely developed its market-oriented accounting systems starting the 1860s and is one of the most advanced in the world. Japan is also a leader in developing

modern management accounting methods. On the other hand, countries such as Viet Nam are now developing modern market-oriented systems after a significant period of economic turbulence and a central planning based accounting system.

It is also interesting to see how easy access to information is enabling the more recently developing economies to leapfrog into some state-of-the-art methods quickly, and yet, how the historical path of each nation influences this development.

The contributors are all very knowledgeable, and have deep experience with their countries, which shows in the thorough and detailed coverage. The editor, Professor Zhijun Lin, brings an extremely wide academic and practical experience to bear on the choice and development of the content.

This book is an important addition to understanding the diversity of accounting in Asia, and will be an important addition to our libraries, and an essential part of courses in international accounting.

Appendixes 2: Guidelines of Qualifications / Responsibilities of the APMAA Officers

Issued in 2013 Revised on December 1, 2017 Revised on December 25, 2018

This guideline aims to keep fairness and equality in the process of choosing the APMAA officers. In the nomination of the APMAA officers, APMAA, in principle, looks at past individual contributions (referring to attendance and past conference hosting records) up to the time of the nomination. The board chair should respect items 1,2,3 of the descriptions (guidelines) below when nominating 2018 APMAA officers.

1. Qualifications / Responsibility of APMAA 2018 Senior Director Candidates

• At least three years' experience as the APMAA director, in principle. This condition however does not apply to professors who will be a chair and/or co-chair of annual conferences and/or doctoral colloquium of the 2018 conference.

• Significant contribution and commitment to APMAA past events as a chair, co-chair of annual conferences and/or doctoral colloquium.

· Consecutive participations in the past 5 year Board meetings and conferences

2. Qualification/ Responsibility of APMAA 2018 Director Candidates

• Multiple participation (in principle, three times or more) in past APMAA overseas conferences is required to be nominated. This condition should be respected but does not automatically apply to professors who are members of an upcoming conference (2018 and 2019) organizing committee (The 2018 conference

organizing committee is allowed exceptionally to recommend at maximum three professors, and the 2019 conference organizing committee is allowed exceptionally to recommend at maximum two professors who do not satisfy the attendance condition.)

• A candidate must submit his/her statement (that shows APMAA career, past attendance record, and the personal commitment to the 2018 APMAA events and activities) with a photo to the board chair by his designated date (December 5, 2017), otherwise he/or she will be deleted from the 2018 candidate list.

• Directors must attend the 2018 Board Meeting. In principle, one is not to be chosen as a 2019 director if he/she fails to commit in the APMAA 2018 Board Meeting attendance and in other activities.

3. Qualification/ Responsibility of APMAA 2018 Steering Committee Member Candidates

• A person with at least one attendance to a past APMAA annual conference and/or a person who is recommended by an APMAA Director is entitled to be nominated to a Steering Committee member candidate.

• A candidate must submit his/her information (about family name, first name; e-mail address, association and APMAA conference attendance) and a brief (around five lines) profile to the Board Chair.
